- **The Health Center is expanding its services for students in grades 6-12.** The Health Center is now offering its free medical health care visits for students virtually, via computer, easily accessed through student Chromebooks. If students are experiencing non-emergency headaches, eye problems, skin problems, stomach problems, breathing issues, sleep problems, joint or muscular pain, anxiety, cold symptoms or cough, sore throat or reproductive health issues, they or their parent(s) can contact THC at help@thehealthcenterww.org to set up a virtual appointment. Parent permission is required for students under age 18 and a fillable form will be provided to be completed before the visit. Appointments are available Monday through Friday and providers will help with referrals if additional care is needed. In-person visits are available for vaccines and physicals as well.
