The Washington State University program recognizes future cougars for their hard work and academic accomplishments. They are looking for students with outstanding academic potential who have demonstrated leadership through contribution to community, family and/or school activities.

The winners will receive a Regents Scholar Award, which provides \$4,000 per academic year for four years.

Those students will then compete for the Distinguished Regents Scholars Award, which covers full tuition and fees for four years, approximately \$42,000.
